We have signed the new contract to sell and bag **Programmes for Fieldays for 2012.**

For those new to the school, this is a whole school initiative. We intend operating the same way as previous years with staff working a full day at Mystery Creek. I will send out a form shortly asking for parents and caregivers to assist. Please fill it in and return to school. We have had a number of people keen to help already. For many parents and caregivers who can't help with selling, the offer to keep their children at home (to support staff at Fieldays selling programmes) is much appreciated.

Before Fieldays the students pack the programmes into bags for which we will receive \$1500 which has increased from 2011 by \$500. We will also receive an increase to 9% of the revenue from the sale of the programmes. This hopefully will mean we raise around \$6000 for our efforts.

This years money will go towards purchasing iPads for classrooms, to assist with student communication and learning.
