# Room 16 Waipa

LIFE CYCLE OF A VOLCANO



Students in Room 16 participated in a topic study on the life cycle of a volcano. Visual boards were used to sequence the life cycle of a volcano. Students learned there are active, dormant and extinct volcanoes. They participated in demonstrations to simulate an eruption of an active volcano. With some support they poured vinegar into playdough and clay model volcanoes they had made. They then added the baking soda and observed the chemical reaction. The students learned about the features of a volcano.
