EASY LOW COST RECIPE

GO, GLOW, GROW PIZZA

- Use wholegrain pita breads as bases
- Spread tomato paste and add your toppings
 - Courgette • Spinach • Onion
 - Mushrooms • Capsicum • Tomato
 - Roast veggies • Pineapple • Ham
 - Cooked Chicken
- Sprinkle with grated cheese and bake in the oven until the base is crispy

TIP:
Choose edam cheese: it's lower in fat!



EASY LOW COST RECIPE

STUFFED SPUDS

- Scrub 5 medium potatoes, prick and microwave till soft; halve potatoes, scoop out and mash flesh
- Cook 1 diced onion and 200g of bacon
- Add 1 tin of creamed corn, 1½C of diced vegetables and mashed potato
- Mix and spoon into potato shells and sprinkle with cheese and bake at 180°C for 10 minutes; serve with salad

TIP:
Try replacing creamed corn with baked beans or chilli beans!
