BAKING

Bought cakes can be high in sugar and fat so try swapping for homemade baking like fruit muffins.

Easy Fruit Muffins

1 & 1/2 cups self raising flour
1/2 cup sugar
1/2 cup low fat milk
1/4 cup oil
1 egg
1 cup any fruit (fresh, frozen, canned)
Mix flour and sugar. Add eggs and liquids.
Fold in fruit. Pour into greased muffin tin.
Bake 20 minutes at 180°C.
