HEAD LICE

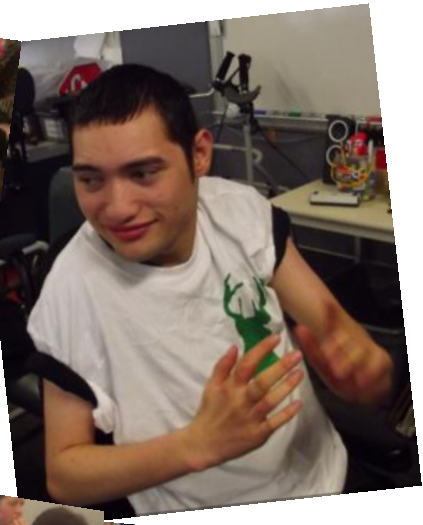
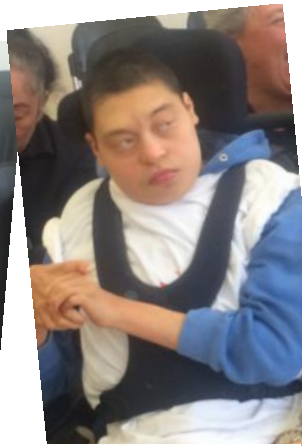
