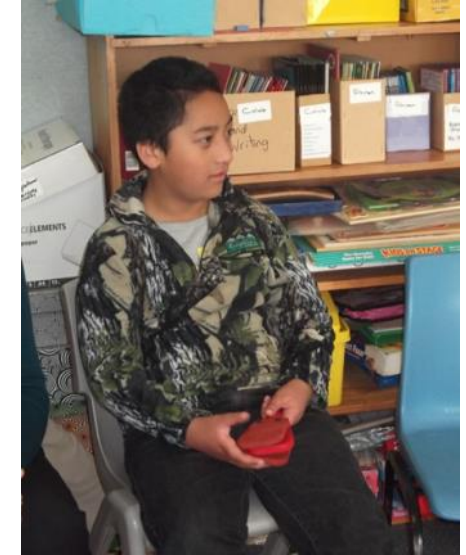
Janet Hodgson:
